- Access to appropriate land and water resources (proof of ownership or lease agreement and water rights)
- Secure access to markets and/or sound knowledge of the market
- Identification of key partners in terms of technical input and market access
- Orientation towards gender, disability and youth

**Accompanying Documentation**

- Proof of registration of entity if applicable
- Updated proof of ownership of land or lease agreement and water rights
- CWDM Declaration of Interest form must be completed and certified
- Legal compliance documents as per your commodity/ties planted or manufactured.
- Valid take off agreement with clear indication of duration to supply commodity/ies or products.
